As we move farther into the holiday season, I wanted to briefly acknowledge what this time of year can look like for alcoholics, especially those who are new or experiencing their first sober holiday. The holidays often come with expectations: how family gatherings should go, how we should feel, how others should act, and how the season is supposed to look. When reality doesn't match those expectations, stress, resentment, and isolation can creep in. For many of us, that gap between expectation and reality has historically been dangerous. This is why the AA message is especially important right now. Meetings held on holidays are not just routine, they can be a lifeline. I want to thank the groups and trusted servants who make sure the doors stay open during this season. It's also a time to be especially mindful of the newcomer. A conversation after the meeting, exchanging phone numbers, or simply being available can make a real difference, particularly when expectations around family and holidays fall short. From a service perspective, the holidays give us an opportunity to practice our principles rather than manage outcomes. Showing up, being helpful, and staying connected can keep us grounded when things don't go as planned. Sobriety during the holidays doesn't have to be perfect, it just has to be sober. One day at a time still works, even in December. Thank you for allowing me to serve as Alternate DCM and for the opportunity to help carry the message during. "The idea of 'living one day at a time' means that I do not regret the past nor wish to shut the door on it, and I do not fear the future." — Daily Reflections.
